Award marks fifth consecutive achievement for Wynn and ALEX, second for Encore

AAA annually evaluates more than 60,000 lodging establishments and restaurants, and only one third of one percent of the over 31,000 properties approved by AAA achieve the prestigious Five Diamond designation.
